

## REPORTS OF SECTION MEETINGS

The sixth meeting of the Far-Western Section of E.T.S. took place on Friday, March 25, 1960, on the campus of BIOLA College, La Mirada, Calif., with about forty in attendance. It constituted a successful reactivation of the Section, and sincere credit is due to the labors of the chairman, Prof. Kenneth B. Daniels, and to his executive committee. The next meeting is scheduled to be held at Los Angeles Pacific College, Avenue 60, on Oct. 28th; and all members and friends who can are urged to attend and to participate.

The fifth general meeting of the Mid-Western Section convened at Calvin Seminary in Grand Rapids, Mich., and extended its sessions over Friday and Saturday, April 1 and 2. The papers and discussions on the theme, "The Inerrancy of Scripture," elicited much interest, both among E.T.S. members and among local pastors and students. About 200 attended. It was voted to meet next in the spring of 1961 at Grace Theological Seminary, Winona Lake, Ind.

The eighth annual meeting of the Southern Section was held at Asbury Theological Seminary, Wilmore, Ky., April 29-30, in conjunction with the Univ. of Ky. Foreign Language Conference at Lexington. A series of fifteen papers and illustrated lectures were presented by members of the Society. The 1961 meeting-place will be Southeastern Bible College, Bermingham, Ala.
