20th Annual Meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society

Westminster Theological Seminary, Philadelphia, Pa., Dec. 26-28, 1968

In recognition of year 1968 marking the twentieth annual gathering of the Evangelical Theological Society, a special program is now being finalized on the theme, "Evangelical Review of Old Testament Studies." Distinguished conservative scholars of the Old Testament from overseas have been invited to bring presentations in the areas of their specializations, including Dr. Donald J. Wiseman of the University of London on Assyriology and the Old Testament, Warden F. Derek Kidner of Tyndale House, Cambridge, on Wisdom Literature; and Dr. Pieter A. Verhoef of Stellenbosch Theological Seminary, South Africa, on The Relationship between the Old and New Testaments.

The meeting, extending over three days, Thursday-Saturday, Dec. 26-28, will be scheduled into six units, on Pentateuch, Historiography, OT Poetry, Prophets, Textual Criticism, and Biblical Theology. Other sections, running concurrently with some of the more technical units, will however be devoted to New Testament, Theology, and the other disciplines. There are planned further informal panels, the presidential address by Dean Kenneth S. Kantzer of Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and ample opportunities for discussion after each presentation.

Members and friends are urged to begin planning now for attendance at this significant gathering, and for sharing this announcement widely with fellow scholars.
