

## REPORTS OF SECTION MEETINGS

The tenth meeting of the Far-Western Section convened at Fuller Theological Seminary, Pasadena, Calif., on March 23, 1962. Papers were read by Drs. Ladd and Thomas, both of which appear in this issue of the *Bulletin*. Dr. Ehlert also presented an exhibit of recent Bible translations. The report has it that it was "a very good meeting."

The second meeting of the Eastern Section took place April 28, 1962, on the campus of Westminster Theological Seminary, Philadelphia, Pa. The theme was "Eschatology," and papers were presented by Drs. Bube, Knudsen, MacRae, Rev. Phillips, and Mr. Yamauchi. A highlight of the day was the panel discussion on "Current Trends in Eschatology."

The seventh general meeting of the Mid-Western Section took place on Friday and Saturday, May 4-5, 1962, at the Moody Bible Institute, Chicago, Illinois. Drs. Anderson, Fieck, Hoekema, Freeman (included in this issue of the *Bulletin*), Longenecker, Prof. Hawthorne, and Rev. Breisch delivered papers, and Dr. Whitcomb gave the presidential address at the banquet. Time for the discussion of the papers was lengthened this year, to the profit of all. The following officers were elected for 1963: Dr. John C. Wenger, Chairman; Dr. J. Barton Payne, Vice-Chairman; and Prof. Charles M. Horne, Secretary.
