**TRAVEL DIRECTIONS
NEW YORK CITY TO NYACK**

By Air — Take the airport limousine to the West Side Airlines Terminal. From there take a taxi to 42nd Street and 8th Avenue. Take a subway train marked IND Uptown "A" Express to the 175th Street stop. Follow the signs underground to the George Washington Bridge bus terminal.

By Train — From the Pennsylvania Station take the subway train marked IND Uptown "A" Express to the 175th Street stop. Follow the signs underground to the George Washington Bridge bus terminal.

—From Grand Central Station take the "Shuttle Train" to 42nd Street and 8th Avenue and then take the subway train marked IND Uptown "A" Express subway to the 175th Street stop. Follow the signs underground to the George Washington Bridge bus terminal.

From the George Washington Bridge bus terminal the bus for Nyack leaves at ten minutes past the hour every hour. The last bus leaves at 11:10 P.M. and the first bus leaves at 8:10 A.M. The trip to Nyack takes about 50 minutes.

In Nyack ask to be let off the bus at Depew Avenue. A representative of the College will be there to drive you up to the College.
