Welcome to the 71st Annual Meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society

The theme for this year's conference, "Christ in All Scripture," reminds us that our Lord Jesus Christ is the heart and climax of biblical revelation, as well as the focus of our faith. While evangelical scholars all affirm that Scripture as a whole testifies to Jesus (as noted in, e.g., Luke 24:44-47; John 5:39; Acts 3:18-24; 10:43; Rom 3:21), we approach that affirmation from diverse angles. Perhaps the greatest diversity comes in how we hear the Old Testament's witness to Jesus, while remaining sensitive to the various documents' genres and ancient settings. Our diverse perspectives can be in tension but can often be complementary.

This year's program will highlight three of the evangelical approaches to recognizing our Lord's presence throughout Scripture. This year's plenary speakers are:

Steve Wellum, Professor of Christian Theology at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary; his publications include (with Trent Hunter) *Christ from Beginning to End: How the Full Story of Scripture Reveals the Full Glory of Christ*.

Jeannine K. Brown, Professor of New Testament at Bethel Seminary; her publications include *Scripture as Communication: Introducing Biblical Hermeneutics*.

Gregory K. Beale, J. Gresham Machen Research Professor of New Testament and Biblical Interpretation at Westminster Theological Seminary; his publications include *A New Testament Biblical Theology: The Unfolding of the Old Testament in the New*.

The program will include hundreds of other valuable papers on this and other topics. In addition to stimulating one another in our academic discussions, across our various traditions and backgrounds, we also look forward to the personal engagement and spiritual fellowship that is a normal part of our experience at these meetings.

As always, gratitude is appropriate for our Executive Committee, our hard-working program committees, the many volunteers whose contributions make each annual meeting successful, and those who serve us at our venue. Special gratitude is in place for our Executive Director, Michael Thigpen, and the Meeting Planner, Bonnie Thigpen, for their faithful and diligent service. Those on the Executive Committee can attest their thorough work and our dependence on them.

P Program Unit Sessions

are a combination of invited papers and proposed presentations which were selected by the program unit steering committees. ETS has three types of program units: Consultations, Study Groups, and Sections. Consultations are new program units which are responsible for one session of invited papers at the annual meeting. Study Groups are narrowly focused groups which require active, collaborative participation by the group members. ETS encourages Study Groups to publish the results of their work. Study groups are responsible for one session of invited papers at the annual meeting. Sections are broadly defined groups that represent general areas of interest. Responsible for one session of invited papers and one session of papers drawn from member submissions, the Sections offer the most access for unsolicited papers.

A Affiliated Society Sessions

feature presentations that were selected and arranged by one of the three societies which join ETS each year: the Evangelical Philosophical Society, the Near East Archaeological Society, and the Adventist Theological Society.

D Discipline Specific Sessions

are composed of presentations that were submitted by ETS members and rated by a panel of scholars who served under the direction of the program chair. These presentations have been grouped into basic disciplines: Old Testament, New Testament, Systematic Theology, Church History/Historical Theology, and Practical Theology.

T Theme Sessions

are composed of presentations submitted by members, which address the conference theme. These presentations were evaluated by a panel of scholars under the direction of the program chair. The theme presentations have been arranged into cohesive sessions based on texts, topics, and methods.
