## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

The Northeast Region of the Evangelical Theological Society will hold its Annual Meeting on Saturday, March 15, 2025, at *Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary* (South Hamilton, MA). This year our theme is "Retrieving Athanasius for Evangelicals Today." Our keynote speaker is Dr. Brandon D. Smith, Chair of the Herschel H. Hobbs School of Theology & Ministry and Associate Professor of Theology & Early Christianity at Oklahoma Baptist University (Shawnee, OK). Dr. Smith has published several recent books, including *Beholding the Triune God: The Inseparable Work of the Father, Son, and Spirit* (co-author; Crossway, 2024); *Taught by God: Ancient Hermeneutics for the Modern Church* (B&H Academic, 2024); *The Biblical Trinity: Encountering the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in Scripture* (Lexham, 2023); and *The Trinity in the Book of Revelation: Seeing Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in John's Apocalypse* (IVP Academic, 2022).

## **Guidelines for your Paper Proposal**

Only approved papers will be presented at the ETS-Northeast Annual Meeting. Presentations must be no longer than 30 minutes, and will be followed by 10 minutes for questions and discussion. A copy of your paper (or at least an outline) should be provided to those present.

The proposal must contain the following information:

- 1. The title
- 2. The purpose of the paper
- 3. A concise summary of the paper (250-500 words)

Please include with your proposal the following personal information:

- 1. Name, address, e-mail, and phone number.
- 2. Are you a professor, student, pastor, or other? (please specify)
- 3. Highest academic degree attained, and from what institution?
- 4. Present position and institution?
- 5. Are you a member of ETS?\*
